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We are now into the final term and what a busy one it will be for the children. The children had enjoyed reading stories with a space theme, we have really enjoyed 'The first Hippo on the moon' and 'Aliens love underpants'. The children continued the theme with decorating underpants and hand printing aliens for display. The children had great time with the cardboard boxes in the garden making space ships and rockets.

The children had been set a challenge to grow the tallest sunflower and the longest bean! The plants were sent home and we hope they are growing well!



We have the arrival of the eggs on Monday 5th June and will have the excitement of watching the ducklings grow. We will be looking for forever homes for the ducklings around the end of June, if you think you may be interested or know someone who might be interested then please speak to Clarissa.

We have started practising for our sports day, the children have been doing running races and practising their balancing skills for the egg and spoon race. Don't forget to start practising for the parent and child three legged race.

30 hours free childcare:

You may be aware that the Government-funded hours for 3–4 year olds will be increasing to 30 per week for eligible families. Sessions:

I would like to make you all aware that many of our sessions are now full based on the current staffing that we have in place. Therefore, if you wish for an adhoc session, we require a minimum 24 hours' notice and will try and accommodate your request if possible.

Can I also remind you that if you are dropping or changing sessions we require a months' notice on sessions. If we do not receive a months' notice on changes, sessions will be charged.

Please can I remind you that parents need to pick up their child on time. We ask that children are picked up on time after every session each day. This is because many sessions run straight after one another and it is only fair that we provide the same settling in procedure for children attending all sessions throughout the day. It can be difficult to settle children in if staff are busy handing children over to their families if families have not picked up on time.
